It is a platform to support and foster Speech and Drama education for our children, our students, our teachers, and us, through publicly presenting performances to help participants acquire self-confidence by performing before an audience.

We find trained, professional adjudicators to give candidates the benefit of expert criticism from unbiased adjudicators, who watch, grade and teach the candidates through their performances. We always task them with maintaining world class standards, with the question “if you saw this work anywhere in the world, what would you think of it?”

## **Our motto – Confidence through Success!**

We run a friendly, motivating festival where our main concern is always the children and young candidates. We believe in Confidence through Success. We love witnessing that moment of self-satisfaction when our candidates finish their performance. This can only come if they have put in the work through preparation, discipline and guidance to perform at the best of their ability. Then they have the reward of Success. This success is made tangible with an individual report, written and verbal, from the adjudicator, and then complemented with a printed certificate.

This Success is what builds the Confidence in our candidates; confidence in themselves and in their abilities. As a balance, if a candidate does not prepare, does not put in the discipline and the hard work, they will be met without success. This, we believe, helps our children learn the value of real success, which leads to real confidence.

## **Who puts the festival together?**

The National Institute of Allied Arts (NIAA) is our governing body who oversee all the Festivals, of which Speech and Drama is just one. Its foundation dates back to 1913 and it continues to uphold its mandate of ‘Building the Arts in Zimbabwe’. A dedicated logistics team manage venues, schedule, catering, payments, printing and so much more; and an organizing committee made up of Speech teachers manage the syllabus, rules and regulations of the Festival. We are grateful for the support of our sponsor CABS.

The Festival was originally set up and continues to be organised by a local group of amateur enthusiasts interested in promoting opportunities to enjoy and participate in the performing arts.

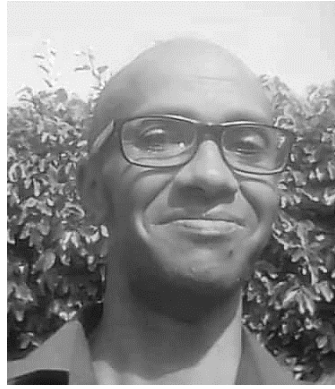
